VALPOLICELLA CLASSICO DOC

Possessioni is a full-bodied, fruity wine, made with Corvina, Rondinella, Molinara and a small percentage of Sangiovese, grown on estates in memory of the family's Tuscan origins.

GRAPE VARIETIES

Corvina, Rondinella, Molinara (*Serego Alighieri clone*), Sangiovese.

TASTING NOTES

Look: lively, ruby red.

Nose: typical cherry aromas, with a slight touch of liquorice.

Palate: well-structured with good acidity and intense aromas of ripe cherries. Long finish with hints of resinated wood.

FOOD PAIRING

Elegant wine suitable for the whole meal. Particularly good with red meat and moderately aged cheeses.



SERVING TEMPERATURE: 18° C

ALCOHOL CONTENT: 13% vol.
