VALPOLICELLA CLASSICO SUPERIORE DOC

Elegant, original, with good structure and complexity. This is the archetype of Valpolicella as described by Hemingway, “as friendly as the house of a favourite brother”. Made on the historic estates belonging to the Conti Serego Alighieri, who for more than 650 years have been part of the tradition and the culture of the Valpolicella region. The personal aristocratic style of this wine is enhanced by the use of the exclusive Serego Alighieri clone of Molinara and by maturation in cherry-wood casks.

### GRAPE VARIETIES

Corvina, Rondinella, Molinara (Serego Alighieri clone).

### APPASSIMENTO

Masi's expertise in grape drying technique.

### TASTING NOTES

**Look:** intense ruby red.

**Nose:** cherry wood and berry fruit.

**Palate:** strong and elegant with hints of cherries preserved in spirit, cloves and vanilla.

### FOOD PAIRING

Elegant and important wine, suitable for drinking throughout the meal; excellent with grilled red meat, roasts and mature cheeses.

On 23<sup>rd</sup> April 1353, Pietro, son of the Supreme Poet Dante Alighieri, bought his first lands at Gargagnago in the heart of Valpolicella Classica. Since then, the aristocratic Serego Alighieri family has passed its love for the land and for its wine down the generations. In 2003, this historic family celebrated 650 years of uninterrupted inhabitation in this place, making a limited production of Valpolicella, the emblematic wine which demonstrates the region's rich oenological traditions.
