GARGANEGA E SAUVIGNON DEL VENETO IGT

Since 1353 the Counts Serego Alighieri have taken care of the winemaking aspect of their own properties. The light aging in cherry barrels gives unmistakable personality to this red wine of body, fruity and spicy. An elegant wine for multiple matching with food.

#### GRAPE VARIETIES

Garganega, Sauvignon.

#### TASTING NOTES

**Look:** pale straw yellow with light green reflections.

**Nose:** typical Sauvignon fruitiness with hints of pears.

**Palate:** good structure balanced with refreshing acidity, and a dry finish.

#### ENJOYING THIS WINE

An elegant glass with slightly aromatic notes, ideal for aperitif time. At the table it accompanies the recipes of contemporary cuisine, light but tasty, or based on fish, vegetables and white meat. Try it with the flavors of oriental cuisine. Serve chilled.
