TOSCANA IGT

Born among the Tuscan hills of Cinigiano in Poderi BellOvile, this wine marks the return of Dante's descendants to their native region. Respect for organic production methods has yielded a superb red wine with a rich bouquet of berries and licorice notes.

GRAPE VARIETIES

Sangiovese, Canaiolo, Ciliegio.

TASTING NOTES

Look: deep ruby red with violet reflections.

Nose: strong berry fruit and liquorice.

Palate: firm and richly fruity, but soft and well-balanced at the same time. Plums and sweet spices. Delicate with a long finish.

EXPERIENCE

Although robust, thanks to its extreme softness it is particularly easy to combine at the table. It goes well with grilled meat and vegetables in summer. Ideal for pasta with meat sauce, cold cuts and cheeses, roasted meats (especially lamb).



SERVING TEMPERATURE: 18° C

ALCOHOL CONTENT: 13% vol.

SHELF LIFE: Potential for medium to long ageing



The purchase of the "Poderi del Bello Ovile" vineyards, marks the return of this aristocratic family to their native land after dedicating more than 650 years to viticulture and winemaking in Valpolicella.
